On the above date and time (151) did respond to a second call in the area of the CVS in Faith Plaza for a report of a sick raccoon. Upon arrival RO did see a large group of citizens in the area of CVS, RO was flagged down and noticed a raccoon in front of the CVS on the sidewalk, RO recognized Raccoon from earlier call and noticed that the animal was acting lethargic, was limping and appeared to have some saliva or foam near its mouth. The animal began to approach stores and make entry into several of the buildings also approaching nearby passerby. Responding officers attempted to shout and scare the officer away, throwing snow at it several times to get it to change direction away from members of the general public, the raccoon showed no signs of fear of any of the surrounding crowd and continued to make advances with no reaction to loud noises or the objects thrown near its position. The Raccoon appeared to be exhibiting the signs of rabies and the decision was made in the interest of public safety that the animal needed to be dispatched. RO was advised by Inv. prokrym that due to the proximity of the general public and to the surrounding public areas it was unsafe at this time to discharge a firearm so the decision was made to attempt to safely dispatch the animal using the patrol vehicle. RO and Inv. Prokrym attempted to move the area to a more open location in the parking lot where the animal could safely be dispatched without danger to the public, once the animal was in what was deemed as an open area, at which point RO was able to dispatch the animal.
